### **Out-Right Namibia Newsletter Launch**

Out-Right Namibia today launched the first volume of our 2020 quarterly Newsletter called 'Out-Right News' to be available locally and consumed across borders electronically. The new volume aims to provide a local Namibian Newsletter that discusses current news or specific topics of interest within the LGBTQIA+ community. This is the first Newsletter launch since the first edition in 2017.

Partners, stakeholders and readers around the country will be able to enjoy this new edition when the Newsletter will become widely available at institutions and our online platforms.

Together with other sexual and gender diverse Civil Society Organisation' (CSO), ORN's focus is on overturning unfair colonial and discriminatory laws that negatively affect LGBT+ persons, sex workers and feminist women's rights, demanding greater protections from the state and its agencies.
